

# RARITAN RIVER BRIDGE REPLACEMENT PROJECT

## Notice of Public Information Session

New Jersey Transit Corporation (NJ TRANSIT), in cooperation with the Federal Transit Administration (FTA), is hosting a Public Information Session for the Raritan River Bridge Replacement Project. NJ TRANSIT is proposing to replace the Raritan River Drawbridge with a new bridge located near the existing bridge. The purpose of the project is to address the vulnerability of the existing bridge to major storm events to enhance the reliability of railroad operations on the North Jersey Coast Line. The project is located in Perth Amboy and South Amboy in Middlesex County, New Jersey.

NJ TRANSIT will prepare an Environmental Assessment / Section 4(f) Evaluation in accordance with the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA), Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act, and Section 4(f) of the U.S. DOT Act. Detailed information about the project will be available at the Public Information Sessions.
